

ICU#7 – Worldwide upcoming innovation drivers

Method, raw clusters and reference list

1. Method

1. This ICU is based upon a semantic analysis of about 17 500 articles from international Press Agencies, newspapers and specialised journals, collected from 26 May 2008 to end of March 2009. By definition, all results presented are '*as of*' the period concerned.
2. In addition to Press Agencies News and to specialised journals, the newspapers are the most important ones of about 20 countries: China, Denmark, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Korea, Russia, Spain, Sweden, Swiss, Taiwan, Turkey, UK and the US. On the whole, 250 different sources were used.
3. In the first place, the articles are collected because they contain the root word: 'innovat*'.
4. In addition to 'innovat*', the articles analysed for this ICU were all those collected during the quarter from December 2008 to end of February 2009. There are 4,793 articles meeting this criterion. After cleansing, 4, 101 articles were subject to the semantic cluster analysis.

2. Clustering

Given the amount of information, the highest two level clusters only are presented hereafter; analysing the clusters entails getting back to the documents that structure them.

Cluster 1: *bank, market, company, consumer, economy, sector, government, product, car (1589 documents)*

Sub-cluster 1.1: *brand, consumer, product, quarter, costumer, sale, company, food, revenue, store (492 documents)*

Sub-cluster 1.2: *gouvernement, economy, tax, sector, policy, country, growth, investment, state, crisis (492 documents)*

Sub-cluster 1.3: *bank, insurance, fund, banking, risk, loan, credit, investor, bond, regulator (399 documents)*

Sub-cluster 1.4: *car, vehicle, auto, motor, emission, automaker, Chrysler, Toyota, energy, battery (206 documents)*

Cluster 2: *students, school, education, research, science, drug, study, technology, health, company (1049 documents)*

Sub-cluster 2.1: *firm, innovation, business, company, strategy, product, process, knowledge, performance, customer (333 documents)*

Sub-cluster 2.2: *student, school, education, teacher, child, college, university, course, programme, science (297 documents)*

Sub-cluster 2.3: *drug, patient, health, GlaxoSmithKline, treatment, company, cancer, trial, disease, product (277 documents)*

Sub-cluster 2.4: *farmer, syndication, science, agriculture, centre, research, technology, farm, award, permission (142 documents)*

Cluster 3: *design, building, project, energy, award, construction, technology, system, solution, service (798 documents)*

Sub-cluster 4.3: *police, court, Page, case, crime, prosecutor, officer, law, judge, county (82 documents)*

Sub-cluster 4.4: *funeral, pilot, missile, ship, aircraft, flight, wife, pirate, cemetery, river (46 documents)*

NB: *As a reminder: the clustering analysis is based upon a variant of 'k-means', classic 'bags of words' type; we have chosen to have a maximum of 4 groupings, based on proximities to the entities 'companies' and 'common-nouns'.*
